Employment Status

Part-time, seasonal (November to March) Average 30-40 hours a week, weekday roughly 9 am to 3 pm. Outreach team will work 1 full week on and have 1 full week off, so every other week schedule.

Job Summary

The School Outreach Coach leads our School Outreach Program. They are responsible for introducing all youth at each scheduled school to our program and the game of golf. One coach will lead each station (full swing and putting). The beginning of class parts of the club and safety must be overviewed. The end of each class the coaches are responsible for explaining who we are, what we do, how to sign up, and passing out information on First Tee - Louisville.



Roles and Responsibilities

Coaching:

- Coach School Outreach sessions during gym time.
- Advanced golf knowledge is not necessary, but minimal knowledge required.

Preferred Qualifications

- At Least 18 years of age (Required)
- At least a freshman in college (Preferred, but not required)
- Charismatic, personable, and motivational in working with youth and volunteers
- Flexible scheduling, able to work 5 days a week during school hours
- Interest in the golf business and pursuing a career in sports (preferred, but not required)
- Must have a valid drivers license
- Able to lift up to roughly 50 pounds of equipment
